Dear parents, dear guardians,

The autumn holidays are behind us, and so is summer! The darker season is coming and we are rapidly approaching the Christmas season.

With the 2nd parent letter in the 24/25 school year, we would like to give you an insight into our school life and provide you with relevant information until the Christmas holidays.

#### What has happened so far? - A review

On 22.08.24, 29 new**5th graders**at the Karlschule. The school time at the secondary school began with two great weeks of getting to know each other in which team training and trust were the top priority. During the activity days for grades 5 and 6, the students were able to practice once again how they can be strong together. Before the autumn break, the class went on a trip to the Arnsberg Forest under the motto "Together we are colorful - together we can do it". We would like to thank the companies that have taken on a student for this period and thus made a valuable contribution to their personal development.

In the last school year we have**class council**introduced as mandatory in all classes at the Karlschule. The class council promotes democratic cooperation and participation in the school. It is the democratic forum of a class. In the weekly meetings, the students advise, discuss and decide on topics of their own choosing; on the design and organization of learning and living together in the class and school, on current problems and conflicts, on joint planning and activities.

In addition, the class representatives now meet every 8 weeks with representatives of the student council, the school management and the teaching staff for a**student conference**meet to discuss various topics related to living together.

Through the initiative of the Förderverein Karlschule eV, at least once a month a**action**after school, which are intended to make school life even more colorful. Here, there are joint game afternoons, cooking sessions, craft activities, etc., for which the students must register in advance via Iserv.

We would therefore like to say a big thank you to all colleagues who support these activities with their personnel and make them possible.

And for you, dear parents, dear guardians, there are further opportunities for exchange among each other. Come with teachers, social workers, school management at our monthly **parents' café**in the cafeteria.




